After the Sectorial Conference of the Heads of Central and Devolved Services of the Ministry of Basic Education on the midterm evaluation of the 2021-2022 school year 2021-2022

THE MINISTER OF BASIC EDUCATION

To

Officials in charge of Central and Devolved Services

At the end of the Sectorial Conference of the Heads of Central and Devolved Services of the Ministry of Basic Education relating to the midterm evaluation of the 2021-2022 school year.

I hereby order:

- > To the Secretary General, in concert with the technical structures concerned, to:
- Ensure a smooth organization of the First School Leaving Certificate and the Government Common Entrance Examinations of the 2022 session, under the supervision of Madam the Secretary of State at the Ministry of Basic Education;
- Propose, in collaboration with the Head of the Division of Legal Affairs, the Directorate of the Follow-up of Private Basic Education and the Regional Delegates, sanctions against private schools which do not respect the official book list.
- > To the Inspector General of Services to:
- proceed, in collaboration with the Director of Examinations, and Certification and the Director of Financial and Material Resources to audit the management of examinations for the 2019 to 2021 sessions;

 Ensure the denunciation of all acts of corruption committed during the conduct of official examinations, and submit the list of those principally responsible for such acts.

> To the Inspector General of Education to:

- o reinforce the capacity building of teachers and pedagogic supervisors on distance learning;
- o create distance learning laboratories/Centres in all ten (10) Regions;
- Put in place Reflection Teams on the structure and modalities of end-of- course assessments in conformity with the new curriculum;
- o put in place a curriculum development Committee for continuous reflection on curriculum issues ;
- o organize in consultation with the Secretary General, a national coordination workshop with the Regional Pedagogic Chain;
- Ensure the harmonization of the analysis of the coverage rate of the curricula in quantitative and qualitative terms.

> To the Regional Delegates to :

- ensure the effective participation of Private Basic Education in the FENASSCO League B games, through the collection and payment of the quotas required from this level of education;
- to ensure that the names, surnames, dates and places of birth of candidates are recorded without error when they register for the various examinations of the 2022 session;
- organize the sectorial preparatory meetings for examinations by 13
 May 2022 at the latest;
- ensure that, as soon as the examinations are over, I have a list of those found responsible for indelicacy in the management of candidates' registration fees, together with their disciplinary files;
- ensure that I receive the end of school year reports by the end of July 2022 at the latest;
- o organize the meetings of the Regional Committees of Private Education and provide me with the reports of these meetings before the end of July 2022;

- remind teachers of their responsibilities to teach and evaluate children in strict compliance with professional ethics and deontology;
- ensure the continued implementation of emergency education in crisis areas;
- o continue to ensure the strict application of the security measures adopted, with a view to the smooth running of the examinations of the 2022 session.

I lay premium on the strict application of these instructions.
